New substances in the candidate list (last updated 2022-01-17)

Trioworld REACH statement

The European Union's REACH Directive (EC 1907/2006) is designed to regulate the Registration, Evaluation, Authorization and Restriction of Chemical Substances. REACH legislation was finalized in December 2006 and has been in effect since June 2007.

Trioworld Group is a downstream user and must not place on the market any substances that are not registered in accordance with REACH. It is the supplier to the Trioworld Group or an actor earlier in the supply chain that is required to register the substances. Communication within the supply chain is a key point in this legislation, and in order to prepare for REACH the Trioworld Group close dialogue with raw material suppliers to make sure that they are in compliance with REACH.

The Trioworld Group will use only substances, which are registered or pre-registered in accordance with REACH. At this moment, we do not see any changes in our product portfolio or our ability to supply the products. When new substances are included in the candidate list provided by ECHA we review the presence of SVHC in our products.

The Trioworld Group will fulfil the obligation to pass information up and down the supply chain in accordance with article 31-34.

The materials do not contain substances listed in Annex I or Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 850/2004 on persistent organic pollutants (POPs).
