Substances on the Candidate List (last updated 2023-01-17)

Trioworld REACH compliance statement

REACH is a regulation of the European Union, adopted to improve the protection of human health and the environment from the risks that can be posed by chemicals. REACH stands for Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals. It entered into force on 1 June 2007.

Trioworld Group is ensuring compliance with REACH on a regular basis.

Under REACH Trioworld Group is a downstream user and we are only using substances which are registered or pre-registered in accordance with REACH. To ensure this Trioworld Group is in close dialogue with our raw material suppliers to make sure that they are in compliance with REACH.

According to our Environment Policy Trioworld Group is striving to minimize the use of hazardous chemicals and ensure correct handling of such hazardous chemicals.

When new substances are identified as Substance of Very High Concern (SVHC) and included in the Candidate List¹ Trioworld Group is reviewing possible presence in our products as it can trigger certain legal obligations.

We can now confirm that our products do not contain any substances on the Candidate List, updated on 2023-01-17, in concentration above 0,1%. It do not either contain substances listed in Annex I or Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 850/2004 on persistent organic pollutants (POPs).
